The Stink Bug season is fast approaching, Chalmers Industries is being proactive, and we are determined to stop these pest's before they enter our great land. We have a large fumigation area within our Yarraville and Brisbane depots to cater for all your fumigation requirements.

The Stink Bug season is expected to run from the 1st of September 2018 right through to the 30th of April 2019.

Collectively Chalmers and our valued customers can ensure the Stink Bugs stay away. **How we can achieve this;**

-  AM and PM fumigation will be available.
-  We require quarantine direction prior to containers landing in our depot.
-  We are unable to unpack FAK containers until final clearance from quarantine.
-  Offshore treatment must be confirmed for high risk goods shipped as break bulk, in open top containers or on flat rack containers.
-  Fast turnaround on Fumigated containers.

The brown marmorated stink bug (Halyomorpha halys) is an insect in the family Pentatomidae that is native to China, Japan, the Korean peninsula, and Taiwan. It was accidentally introduced into the United States, with the first specimen being collected in September 1998. The brown marmorated stink bug is an agricultural pest and by 2010–11 had become a season-long pest in U.S. orchards. It has recently established itself in Europe and South America.
